The Herbert Irving Comprehensive Cancer Center, an NCI-designated cancer center at the Health Sciences Campus of Columbia University in New York City, is recruiting one or more biostatistics faculty members to join its program of research in basic, clinical and population sciences.

The successful candidate will hold a faculty position in the Department of Biostatistics, Mailman School of Public Health, Columbia University and will be a member of the Biostatistics Shared Resource of the Herbert Irving Comprehensive Cancer Center. The level and track (tenure or non-tenure) of the appointment will be commensurate with credentials and experience. The faculty member will collaborate with other Cancer Center faculty in the development and execution of funded research projects, will conduct methodological and/or applied research in statistics, and will teach courses in biostatistics. Applicants must hold a doctoral degree in biostatistics or statistics and have a strong record of independent and collaborative research and teaching as well as excellent written and verbal communication skills. Experience and a demonstrated interest in developing and applying statistical methods to important problems in cancer research are required.
