As a post doctorate in the Department of Medical Statistics and Bioinformatics, you take part in a short-term research project on statistical genetics. Your work focuses on the development and application of statistical models for genetic association analysis taking into account additional information such as phenotypes of not genotyped relatives and linkage information. The new methods may be applied to data from the Leiden Longevity Study, which consists of three generation families and to family data on ACPA Positive Rheumatoid Arthritis.
