

2004 MUSC MICROSOFT CAMPUS AGREEMENT SUBSCRIPTION NOTES

- **Microsoft Office Professional and Office for Mac Standard**

Office professional includes the following components: Microsoft Office Word, Microsoft Office Excel, Microsoft Office PowerPoint®, Microsoft Office Outlook®, Microsoft Office Access, and Microsoft Office Publisher. Office for Mac Standard includes Word, Excel, and PowerPoint. Departments are responsible for purchasing their own CD's for installs. These should be purchased from Compusult at a cost of \$30 per set. One set may be used for unlimited installations within that department.
- **Work at home rights - NOT** included in the MUSC enrollment. Higher education faculty and staff are eligible to purchase Academic Education Full Packaged Products which cost much less than regular retail software. By purchasing Academic Edition Full Packaged Products, faculty and staff are not required to limit their usage at home to work related purposes. These may be purchased from Compusult under the state academic contract agreement.
- **Foreign Language Rights** – you are granted the right to run the software in any available language. This includes the right to run the Multi-Language version of Office.
- **Upgrade/Downgrade Rights** – you are granted the right to run new versions of the software products included in the agreement as they are released. Additionally, you may run any previous version of the software. These upgrade and downgrade rights also apply to the individual components of the software.
- **Student Rights** – Students can use the campus agreement licensed software on Campus Computers in classrooms or open access labs, but not on personally owned machines. Students who wish to purchase Academic Education Full Packaged Products may do so from Compusult under the state academic contract agreement.
- **Microsoft Windows Professional Desktop Operating System (OS) Upgrades/Downgrades**

Entitles you to upgrade to the most current version of Windows Professional and Tablet PC editions or downgrade to an older version. For example, if you currently run Windows 2000, you are licensed to upgrade to Windows XP Professional or you can run any of the older versions. **Please note that this is an upgrade only, not a full license.** In order to run any version of a Microsoft Windows operating system licensed through Campus Agreement, you or your users must have a valid license for a Microsoft Windows operating system on each PC on which the software is run. New computers purchased or leased should include the desktop OS when ordered.
- **Microsoft Core Client Access License (CAL)**

A new client access license (CAL) suite is now available through volume licensing—the Core CAL. The Core CAL includes CALs for Microsoft Windows® Server, Microsoft Exchange Server, Microsoft Systems Management Server, and Microsoft SharePoint™ Portal Server. The Core CAL offers a convenient way to license basic server components across desktop computers. In addition, it reduces the overall complexity of managing CALs for server software for IT professionals. The Core CAL replaces the BackOffice Server CAL in all [Volume Licensing](#) offerings.
- **Microsoft Products Not Listed Above**

Other Microsoft Products not listed above (FrontPage, Visio, server OS, Terminal Server CAL, SQL Server CAL, etc.) require licensing through the Campus **Select** Agreement. The licenses and CD's for these products should be purchased Dell under the state select contract agreement.
