ROTATION TITLE: Family Medicine – Inpatient

SITE DESCRIPTION (common diseases states treated, patient demographics, etc):

The most common admitting diagnoses for the Family Medicine Inpatient Service include: CHF exacerbation, angina/MI, asthma/COPD exacerbations, community acquired pneumonia, urosepsis/UTI, atrial fibrillation, sickle cell disease, acute thromboembolism (DVT, PE), stroke and complications from diabetes mellitus.
