ROTATION TITLE: Family Medicine – Ambulatory Care

SITE DESCRIPTION (common diseases states treated, patient demographics, etc):

The Family Medicine Center is a multidisciplinary health care site consisting of attending physicians, mid-level providers, nursing staff and pharmacists. It is used as a training area for medical students, physician assistant students, nurse practitioner students, and pharmacy residents and students. The clinic has two patient care areas and also houses a pharmacy, and laboratory. Clinical pharmacy services include: diabetes education and management referral service, anticoagulation monitoring, drug information services and multidisciplinary patient education and disease state management.
