ROTATION TITLE: Pharmacotherapy Clinic – Ambulatory Care

SITE DESCRIPTION (common diseases states treated, patient demographics, etc):

The Pharmacotherapy Clinic is a pharmacy-operated free-standing clinic located in the Rutledge Tower Pharmacy on the 1st floor of Rutledge Tower. Patients are referred to the clinic by attending physicians, mostly medicine sub-specialists and surgeons, for a variety of clinical pharmacy services. Once referred, patients are followed by the clinic pharmacists using protocols that have been approved by the pharmacy credentialing committee.
